



MWI2007 – Data Sheet

MWI2007 extends the unified messaging solution of Microsoft Exchange Server 2007 with Message Waiting Indicator (MWI) and SMS/pager text messaging capabilities. MWI for Exchange Server 2007 notifies a user that they have received a voice message from either their desk line or their cellular phone by lighting the lamp on their desktop phone and by sending an SMS text message to their cellular phone. MWI2007 is flexible and scalable, being suitable for small installations and large enterprise-wide deployments; it can be implemented on the same server as Exchange 2007 or on a separate platform, and has a simple web-browser interface for ease of administration, monitoring, reporting and troubleshooting..

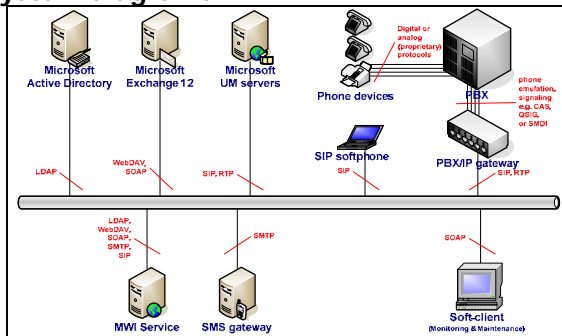
- Communicates with Active Directory

- Gives SMS-based administration interface for users (v2.0)
- Sets MWI through IP-PBX media gateways (separated or blinded) for analog and digital extensions
- Sets MWI for SIP extension
- Sends SMS-s through SMS-email media gateways

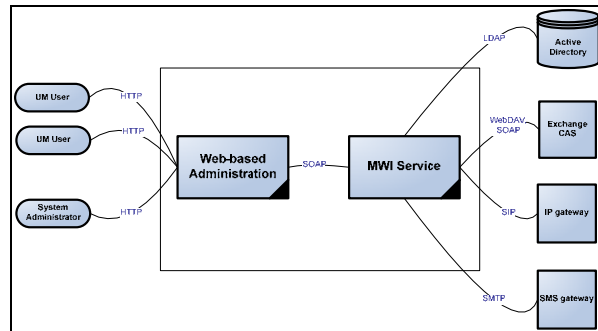
